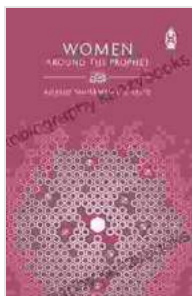

Khadeeja: The Pioneering Believer



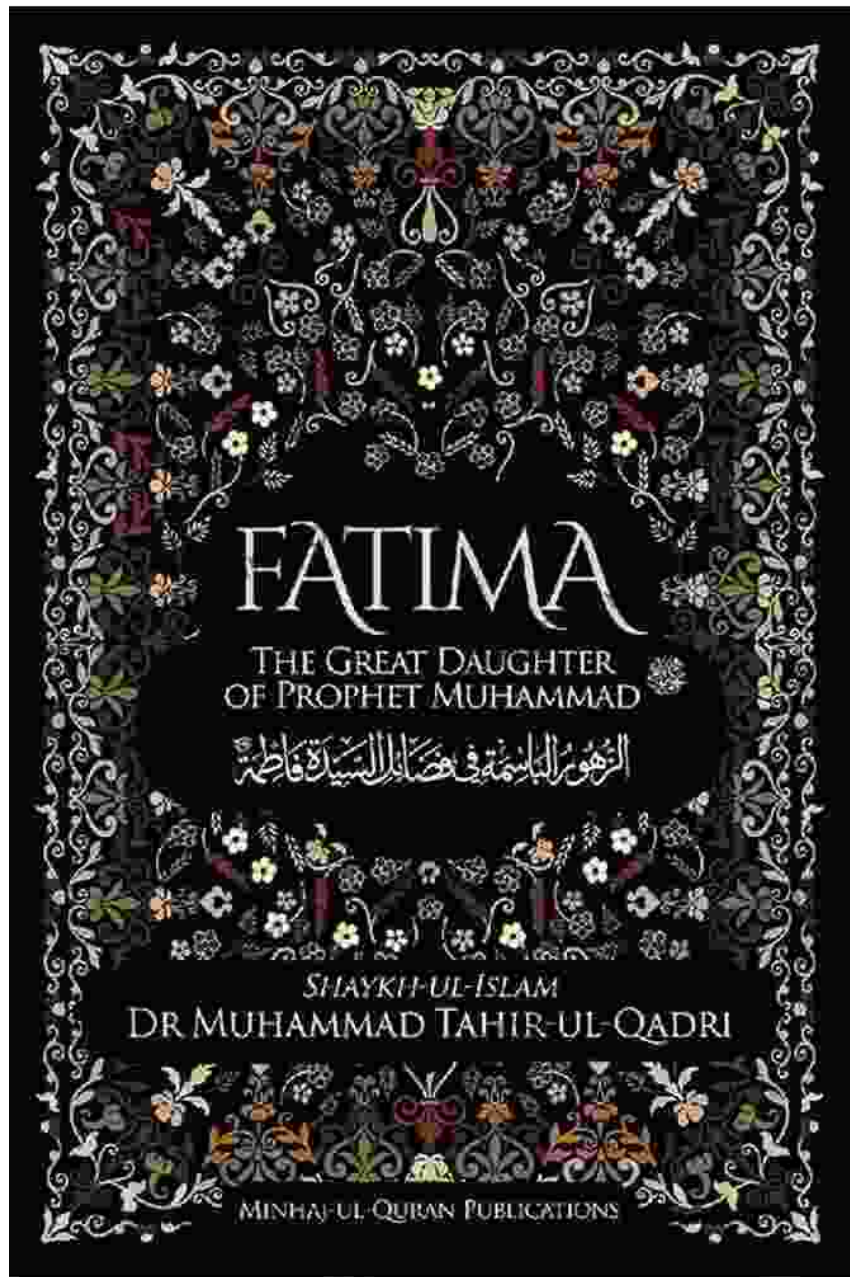
